Now its Def Leppard. Guitarist Phil Collen recently released a memoir called "Adrenalized," spilling all the dirt about being in that band! From 1988, here's "Pour Some Sugar On Me."

(JINGLE INTO SONG #2 Eddy Grant- Electric Avenue)

(TALKDOWN SONG #2: Eddy Grant-Electric Avenue)

Backtrax USA --a decade of 80s hits every weekend! From 1983, Eddy Grant sang "Electric Avenue."

(TEASE MOVIE or TV CLIP & INTRO: SONG #3 Eurythmics-Here Comes the Rain Again)

Hey, I'm Kid Kelly, playing the 80s music you need, two hours every weekend. Now listen to THIS 80s TV memory...[REAL PEOPLE]. OK, that's a clip from this weekend's Backtrax 80s Tube Test, and here's a clue -- it was one of the earliest reality shows. Stay right here for your answer, comin up.

(JINGLE SEGUE INTRO SONG #6 *Joan Jett-I Love....*)

(BTUSA I.D. INTO STOPSET #2)

(KELLY JINGLE OUT OF STOP SET #2)

(INTO SONG #7: *Dead Or Alive-You Spin Me...*)

Here's more to this weekend's Backtrax 80s Tube Test: you never knew what kinds of wierd talents your neighbors had. Stay here -- another clue, and your answer, comin!

Now, back to 1985 for Dead Or Alive and "You Spin Me Round."

(JINGLE INTO SONG #8: *Hall and Oates-Say It Isn't So*)

(INTO SONG #9: *Naked Eyes-Always Something There...*)

Backtrax USA –your favorite 80s hits! From 1983, that's Hall and Oates with 'Say It Isn't So.'

Now stayin' at '83, here's Naked Eyes with "Always Something There to Remind Me."

I'm talking about the show that introduced us to everyone from a guy who ate dirt to folks from a hollering convention. Before "America's Funniest Home Videos," there was "Real People" and we were watching it in 1981!

OK, hang out for more 80s hits – 'cause they're comin'!

(OUT OF STOPSET #2: INTO SONG #10 Bon Jovi-Livin On A Prayer)

(TEASE LYRIC OF SONG #11)

(INTO SONG #15 dead segue unless song #14 is a dropped, then jingle here instead of dead segue) Prince-Litte Red Corvette)

***(OUTRO BACKSELL STOPLESS SET Starting with song #15 and
backselling to song #11)***

(TALK INTO STOPSET #4: SPOTS)

Backtrax USA - the best 80s music! That's Prince – and look for a new documentary about him in a few months. But from 1983, he sang "Little Red Corvette." [Before it, and from 1981, Rod Stewart did "Young Turks."] Journey did "Open Arms" from 1982, and also from '82, we heard Men At Work with "Who Can It Be Now." Finally, the Gap Band started us off with "Outstanding" from 1983.

Starting up more big 80s hits at the year that...

...after blowing the lid off the financial shenanigans of the PTL TV ministry, church secretary Jessica Hahn reveals a racy new look, thanks to plastic surgery...

....we're back to when we're watching Kevin Costner and Tim Robbins in the hot baseball movie, "Bull Durham"

...and we're back to when Michael Jackson releases his autobiography, "Moonwalk"

Was it 1987? 1988? Or 1989? The year was...1988. It's when Guns N Roses has an 80s hit with THIS song. Here's "Welcome to the Jungle."

(JINGLE INTO SONG #17 Spandau Ballet-True)

(TALKDOWN SONG #17 Spandau Ballet-True)

Backtrax USA - 80s hit radio! That's Spandau Ballet, with a song inspired by a real-life, PAINFUL crush! It happened to guitarist Gary Kemp. From 1983, "True."

OK, now listen to THIS...[BACKWARDS TRACK CLIP]. Think you recognize this weekend's Backward Track? I'm Kid Kelly, and we'll hear it, soon!

Madonna-Dress You Up)**

Hi, welcome again! I'm Kid Kelly, right back to the Big 80s hits. Remember to "like" our Facebook page next time you're online. Now it's Madonna. From 1985, here's "Dress You Up."

**(JINGLE INTO SONG #19 Billy Idol-Dancing with Myself)
(SWEEPER INTO SONG #20 REO Speedwagon-Can't Fight...)
(BACKSELL SONG #20 REO Speedwagon-Can't Fight...)**

Backtrax USA -- home of 80s hits! From 1985, REO Speedwagon did "Can't Fight This Feeling." Before it was Billy Idol, who has his own satellite radio show. But from 1981, he sang "Dancing with Myself."
